Ko e Palani Ngāue 'a e Potungāue Fefakatau'aki mo e Langa Fakalakalaka Faka'ekonomika, óku fakahaa'i ai 'a e ngaahi ngāue kuo fokotu'utu'u ke tokoni ki he fakalakalaka 'a e fefakatauáki pea mo e ngaahi fiemaú fakakomesiale á e Fonua. Óku í ai mo e tokanga makehe ki he ngaahi pole mo e ngaahi faingamalie ki hono Paotoloaki 'a e Tupulekina Faka'ekonomika.

Hangē ko ia 'i he Polokalama Patiseti ki he Ta'u Fakapa'anga 2023, kuo tofanga 'a Tonga ni 'i ha ngaahi fakatamaki fakanatula fakatuúpakē. Ko e saikolone fakatalopiki ko Kita 'i he 2018 na'a ne fakatupunga ha maumau mo ha mole lahi 'o fakafuofua ki he peseti 'e 3.0 'o e GDP fakata'u. Naé hoko mai ai á e saikolone fakatalopiki ko Haloti pea a'u mai moe mahaki fakaúhuha 'i he ta'u 2020 mo e mapuna 'a e moúnga afi 'i he 2022, á ia í he hokohoko 'a hono uesia 'a e fonua 'e he ngaahi fakatamaki fakanatula é í ai á éne uesia lahi á étai tuúnga faka'ekonomika.

Ko e mapuna á e Hunga Tonga Hunga Haápai í Sanuali 2022, pehē ki he aú mai á e COVID-19 kuo ne uesia lahi 'a e tuúnga fakaéconomika á Tonga ni.

'I he ta'u 'e tolu (3) ka hoko mai, 'e hokohoko atu ai 'a e Potungāue 'i he fengāue'aki vāofi mo e ngaahi kupu fekau'aki 'i hono fokotu'utu'u 'o ha ngaahi founiga ke fakalelei'i 'aki 'a e 'atakai fakapisinisi ke malava 'o a'usia 'a e tupu faka'ekonomika 'oku fakalukufua pea tu'uloa.

‘Oku tokoni ‘a e Potungāue Fefakatau’aki mo e Fakalakalaka Faka’ekonomika ki hono a’usia ‘a e visone fakalukufua ‘o e Palani Langa Fakalakalaka ‘a Tonga II (TSDF II) ‘a ia ko *hono ‘Paotoloaki ‘a e fakalakalaka ke fakalekesi ‘a e mo’ui ‘a e taha kotoa*’, ‘o fakafou ‘i ha tu’unga faka’ekonomika ‘oku kaunga ki ai ‘a e toko taha kotoa, tu’uloa pea longomo’ui ai ‘a hono ngāue’aki ai ‘o e ‘ilo. ‘Oku tokoni ‘a e Potungāue ki hono a’usia ‘a e kaveinga ngāue fakafonua fakafou ‘i he ngaahi fokotu’utu’u fakangāue’anga ‘e tolu (3):

1.2: *Ngāue vāofi ange ‘a e Pule’anga’ mo e Sekitoa Taautaha’ ke tokoni ki he tupu fakaéconomika.*

1.3: *Lelei ange ‘a e ‘atakai fakahoko pisinisi.*

1.5: *Lelei ange ‘a e faingamālie mo e kau ki he fefakatau’aki mo tuápuleángā, ma’u ngāue pea mo e ínivesimeni muli.*

Ko e Palani Ngāue ko éni ko e ola ia á hono toe fakaleleií ó e ngaahi Palani Ngāue á e Potungāue ki he taú 2021/2022-2023/24. Kuo fakaleleií ia ke fakahoko mai ai á e ngaahi visone mo e hala fononga kuo fokotuú mai é he taki foóu ó e Potungāue pea mo e feinga á e Potungāue ke tokoni ki he langalanga hake ó e tuúnga fakaéconomika hili ko ia á e COVID-19 pea mo e puna á e moúnga afi Hunga Tonga Hunga Haápai. Ko e ngaahi visone, taumuá ngāue mo e ngaahi tefitoí úlungaanga éni óku makatuúnga ai á e fakahoko fatongia á e Potungāue:

Visone- Takimuá í hono fakafaingamalieí á e tupu mo e fakalakalaka á e sekitoa taau taha.

Misiona – Ke toe malohi ange á e fengāueáki pea mo e kotoa ó e ngaahi kupu fekauáki kotoa pe ke toe ola lelei mo vave ange á hono fakahoko étau ngaahi ngāue.

Tefitoí úlungaanga – Ngāue fakataha, Ílo foóu, Tali ui ki he fatongia pea mo e Fatongia fakalukufua ó e Potungāue.

1.2 NGAALI HOA NGĀUE

'Oku mahu'inga'ia 'a e Potungāue Fefakatau'aki mo e Fakalakalaka Faka'ekonomika 'i hono fakahoko 'a hono ngaahi fatongia 'o fakatatau ki he ngaahi fiema'u 'a 'ene kau kasitomā pea pehē ki he ngaahi hoa ngāue. Ko e ngaahi hoa ngāue á e Potungāue óku kau kotoa ki ai á e ngaahi pisinisi í he sekitoa taau taha á ia óku tokonií é he Potungāue fakafou í he ngaahi fakataha mo e kau pisinisi pea mo e ngaahi fakalelei. Ko e tafaáki ki he Tokangaekina á e Totonu á e Konisiuma pea mo e Fefakatauáki Lelei óku nau fakahoko á e ngaahi polokalama ako ke toe fakaleleií á hono maluí ó e totonu á e kau fakatau. Óku fengāueáki á e Potungāue pea mo e ngaahi Potungāue kehe ó tautau tefito ki he Potungāue Tanaki Paánga mo e Tukuhau pea mo e Potungāue Ngoue ke fakafaingofuaí á e átakai fakapisinisi pea mo tokoni ki he ngaahi pisinisi fakalotofonua ke fakalahi á e langa hake ó e tafaáki hū koloa ki tuápuleángā.













1 MTED CORPORATE PLAN EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Ministry of Trade and Economic Development contributes to the TSDF II overall vision of creating “*a more progressive Tonga supporting a higher quality of life for all*”, through the national economic objective or TSDF II national economic outcome of a more inclusive, sustainable and dynamic, knowledge-based economy. MTED contributes to the achievement of the national economic outcome through three (3) key organizational outcomes:

- 1.2 Closer public private partnership for economic growth
- 1.3 Strengthened business enabling environment
- 1.5 Better access to and use of overseas trade and employment and foreign investment

This Corporate Plan is a result of a review of the previous Corporate Plans of the Ministry for the year 2021/22 – 2023/24. It has been revised to reflect the vision and direction of the Ministry’s new leadership and the Ministry’s response in the wake of the COVID-19 global pandemic for which the economy has been widely affected and the unprecedented Hunga Tonga Hunga Ha’apai Volcanic Eruptions. The Ministry’s vision, mission and values are set out below:

Our Vision – Leader in enabling private sector growth and development

Our Mission – Commitment to strengthen partnership with all stakeholders to effectively and efficiently deliver our services.

Our Values – Teamwork, Innovation, Performance Orientated, Accountability and Whole of Ministry Responsibility.

Furthermore, the Government of Tonga’s Strategic Development Framework 2015–2025 provides the long-term national strategy for development. The new government has established and will focus delivery of its nine (9) priority agendas, in which MTED will specifically focus on the following GPAs;

Challenges and Opportunities for Progressive Economic Growth

GPA 7: Creation of trade opportunities from regional and international trade agreements focusing on agriculture, fisheries, handicrafts, tourism and promoting of value addition and product diversification and simultaneously reduce technical barriers to private sector development and heavy reliance on imports;



1.5 TSDF IMPACTS AND OUTCOMES SUPPORTED BY MDA OUTPUTS

As previous illustrated in the Result Map in section 1.3, the Ministry contributes to the achievement of the three economic organisational outcomes through four (4) key major outputs or areas:

1. Trade and investment services
2. Business registry & Intellectual Property services
3. Consumer services; and
4. Labour services.

Under these areas, there are six (6) key organisational outputs:

1. *Efficient and effective leadership and management;*
2. *Strengthen public/private partnership and enable greater access to overseas trade;*
3. *Strengthened targeted support programs that increases Tongan exports, encourage import substitution and built the production capacity of local businesses;*
4. *Enabling business environment that is conducive to inclusive, sustainable and resilient economic growth and investment;*
5. *Strengthened consumer awareness and redress mechanism to empower and protect the interest of consumers; and*
6. *Better labour market conditions and standards that support business growth, decent work and higher labour participation.*

These six (6) organisational outputs are delivered through six (6) programs. All these programs contribute to the TSDF II organisational outcome of promoting a closer and effective public private partnership that supports economic growth. As indicated in the Ministry's result map, the Ministry has set a clear mission in this corporate plan to strengthen the working partnership with all the stakeholders, to ensure that the Ministry delivers its services effectively and efficiently.

The TSDF II organizational economic outcome for creating an enabling business environment that is conducive to inclusive, sustainable and resilient economic growth, is delivered through three (3) programs, the **Business Registry, Investment & IP Program, Trade Negotiation & Facilitation Program and the Business Support Program.** The TSDF II organizational outcome for better access to economic opportunities overseas including trade, employment and foreign investment is delivered through four (4) programs, the **Trade Negotiation & Facilitation Program, Labour Program, Consumer Protection and Fair-Trade Program and Business Support Program.**

1.6 SECTOR PLANS & STRATEGIES

Once again, as illustrated in the Result Map in section 1.3, the Ministry contributes to the following Sector Plans and Strategies:

1. Tonga Trade Policy Framework
2. Tonga E-commerce Strategy & Road Map
3. Tonga Investment Facilitation & Promotion Strategy
4. Tonga Energy Road Map (TERM Plus); and
5. Tonga Labour Mobility Policy.

Tonga Trade Policy Framework 2017 - 2025

The Tonga Trade Policy Framework (TTPF) serves as a guide to all Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs) in terms of trade related priorities that should be pursued up to 2025. The TTPF also provides the corresponding implementation action plan for indicative actions and use as a measure of progress. The policy measures are grouped into four pillars:

1. **Industrial and investment development**, i.e., improvements in the productive capacity of Tongan businesses, both to increase export competitiveness and to compete with imports on the domestic market and goods;
2. **Export development and trade facilitation** with a focus on increasing and diversifying Tongan exports;
3. **Development of trade supporting institutions and services**, thereby overcoming the identified institutional and capacity constraints of trade policy setting and implementing bodies, both public and private; and
4. **Inclusivity and citizen economic empowerment** to ensure that TTPF measures are indeed in line with the TSDF II objective of contributing to a higher quality of life for all Tongans.

The Ministry of Trade and Economic Development is responsible for leading approximately 80% of the measures stipulated in the Implementation Matrix of the TTPF, and each of these measures falls under the different divisions of the Ministry. For example, implementing measures to promote consumer preferences for locally produced goods falls under the Consumer Protection and Fair-Trade Division of the Ministry. Other measures will fall under the mandates of relevant agencies.

As a leading agency in a measure, MTED will be responsible for the strategic management, coordination and implementation, working in partnership with other Ministries and agencies, the private sector, civil society and other stakeholders. MTED will also be directly responsible for the monitoring of core areas. In other measures where MTED is not the implementing agency, MTED will be restricted to that of a subsidiary monitoring body, while primary monitoring will be affected by the responsible institution.

One of the core components of the Industrial and Investment Development Pillar is Enhancing the Business/ Investment Environment. The Business Registry, Investment and Intellectual Property's output is to have an Improved business registry system and investment climate that is conducive for business start-up, business growth and investment. This program is responsible in making sure that the business needs are being met and the business environment is favourable and encouraging to businesses.

Tonga E-commerce Strategy and Road Map

The Tonga E-commerce Strategy and Roadmap (TESR), predominately focuses on the Business-to-Consumer (B2C) and the Business-to-Business (B2B) models. The strategy's vision is for a transformative economy where most Tongan businesses and consumers actively engage in domestic and cross-border electronic commerce. Its mission is to accelerate Tonga's Digital Transformation through accelerated economic growth that is inclusive and equitable. It has four overarching outcomes:

1. More online consumers
2. More online businesses
3. An increasing banked population and its corollary the reduction of cash handling; and
4. A digital literate population

The governance of the strategy falls under the national E-commerce Committee established under the auspices of the Ministry of Trade and Economic Development. MTED provides secretarial support to the Committee.

A critical component of the TESR is the E-commerce Roadmap and Implementation matrix with 60 measures under 7 priorities areas:

1. Vision for e-commerce and the ecommerce ecosystem
2. Trade Logistics and Trade Facilitation
3. ICT Infrastructure
4. Payment solutions, digital financial inclusion and access to financing
5. Legal and Regulatory Framework
6. Skills Development for E-commerce
7. Access to Financing

The Ministry of Trade and Economic Development is responsible for 50% of the measures indicated in the TESR.

Tonga Energy Road Map (TERM Plus)

The Consumer Protection & Fair-Trade program, as Secretariat to the Petroleum regulator under the Competent Authority contributes to the TERM Plus through the Petroleum Reform project and the implementation of the monthly and quarterly petroleum and LPG price. The TERM-PLUS sets the investment projects to reach 70% renewable electricity target by 2030 and 100% by 2035. This follows the first Tonga Energy Road Map issued in 2010.

As part of the energy transition, the TERM-PLUS framework highlights the importance of reliable and cost-effective supply of petroleum over the period and outlines plans for the optimisation of the petroleum supply. This includes direct supply of oil products from the major Asian trading centres (Singapore) which is aligned with the Medium Range project being covered in the framework. The Petroleum Reform project is a joint initiative with the Energy Department to assess how to progress with the implementation of supply optimisation with the target to improve Tonga's petroleum supply security and resilience. This is in alignment with the Energy Supply short- and medium-term interventions for direct shipments of oil products from other countries.

Tonga Labour Mobility Policy

The Labour Program of the Ministry continuously supports the vision of the Tonga Labour Mobility Policy (TLMP) through the implementation of strategies to provide accurate Labour market information. This information will ensure evidence-based policy recommendations to increase employment job placements of the unemployed in Tonga.

The Ministry in coordination with the Ministry of Internal Affairs works on establishing TLMP's priority sectors by conducting Labour Market surveys and ongoing assessment of the impact of labour mobility on the domestic labour market and private sector development. The Labour program also contributes in the development and implementation of a regulatory reform program to improve the management of labour mobility as well as facilitate the delivery of the TLMP objectives. The Employment Regulations Acts 2020 serves this purpose.



2.4 SUMMARY OF MTED PLANNED MAJOR REFORMS

The Government, through the Ministry of Finance, have set its priorities agenda (GPA) in the “Budget Strategy and Funding Envelope 2022/23” with nine (9) government priority agendas which are grouping into 3 thematic areas: i). National Resilience, ii). Quality of Service and Affordability and iii). Challenges and Opportunities for Progressive Economic Growth. The Ministry had taken the GPA into consideration, in addition to the TSDF II outcomes, during the Ministry’s corporate planning and budgeting exercise for the Medium-Term Budget Framework FY2020/2021.

Under the Economic Development, the GPA highlighted the need for continued investment in the development of Agriculture, Fisheries and Tourism. The Ministry have reviewed its relevant activities that will assist in these areas. Specifically, this is under the **Business Support Division** which handles developments in *community businesses, informal sector, local businesses and the export sector*.

The Investment and Export Division, through its trade information and market research activities, and export marketing promotion activities is also in line with this GPA. A market representative is being proposed for the New Zealand and Australian market to increase market access for Tongan exports particularly for exports from grassroots communities in Tonga in these three economic sectors.

The GPA have also highlighted the need for a clear Investment Policy to facilitate economic development. The Ministry is in full support of this priority and is in the forefront of encouraging investments with the development of the **Foreign Investment Act**. The **Business Registry Division** also wishes to upgrade their **Business Online Registration System** to facilitate online payment gateway and Foreign Investment Registry. This OUTCOME will increase foreign investment into the country with the ease of doing business in Tonga.

MTED also takes the wellbeing of its staff very seriously and a new initiative is being proposed to compact non-communicable disease. The Ministry appreciate that this is being highlighted in the GPA as a high risk in terms of having a severe impact on the performance of government. Government should be the leading agency in compacting this crisis as unhealthy staff does not only decrease productivity, but it is also costly to government.

The Ministry has identified the following new initiatives for the upcoming years to assist in achieving the relevant GPA and national outcome relating to the Ministry.

The Ministry's proposed new initiatives are shown in the table below in order of priority and proposed timeframe. These proposals are not necessarily with funding.






Program 1: Leadership and Corporate Services Division Structure




Program 2: Trade Negotiation and Facilitation Division Structure




Program 3: Business Support Division Structure
